College applications are due this summer for early admission, October for UCs, and November for CSUs. We encourage you to use this extra 4 days that we are giving you for Easter Break to go visit the colleges and universities that you are interested in going to. **DO NOT JUST APPLY TO A COLLEGE WITHOUT VISITING FIRST.** Get their application forms. Visit their financial aid office. Visit their international student office. *Please don't waste your time just staying home, working, or playing games.*

STUDY FOR AND TAKE SAT/ACT IF YOU WANT TO APPLY TO A UNIVERSITY

If you are interested in going to university then you will need to take the SAT or the ACT. Junior Colleges do not require the SAT. UCs require SAT and SAT Subject Tests. CSUs require SATs alone.

June 4th SAT (May 11th deadline, May 25th late deadline)

Stanford Achievement Testing

MARCH 21st – 24th, 2016

Greetings ADCS family,

In 10 days we will be doing assessment tests for our students in nearly every grade level of our school. Attached to this letter you will find the testing schedule. These examinations were designed by Stanford University to test students on the things they should have learned for each grade level. It is very important for student's futures and to assess where their strengths are and where there may be some weaknesses. If the students do well then this will help improve the school's reputation as the collective scores of the students will be compared to those of other schools all over the nation. ***The stronger the school's reputation, the greater the value of a student's high school diploma. If the students complete the test without issues then there will be no school on Thursday, March 24th.***

We need our students to be at school promptly at 8:30 am otherwise they will need to stay after noon time to retake the section of examination that was missed the day prior.

All of our days will end at NOON TIME (12 pm) EXCEPT Wednesday where school will end at 12:45 pm.
